


COMMUNITY EXPOSURES

Bar 47 in partnership with the [Meagher County Health Department](#) are warning of a possible exposure to COVID-19 for anyone who visited Bar 47 on October 8th, 9th, or 10th from the hours of 4pm-9pm. People who were at the bar during those evenings should monitor themselves for symptoms. Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea. The Health Department says anyone with those symptoms should talk to their health care provider and get tested for the virus. People are advised to remain at home after being tested. A close contact is anyone who is within 6 feet of a positive case for a total of 15 minutes.

** Data to inform the definition of close contact are limited. Factors to consider when determining close contact include proximity, duration of exposure (longer exposure time likely increased exposure risk), and whether the person was a person with symptoms (coughing likely increases exposure risk).

If there is enough interest in testing, Meagher County Health Department will set up testing early next week for concerned citizens.

At this time, we are still open for business. All close contacts are in quarantine and we are continuing our sanitizing protocols. We thank you for your patronage and cooperation during these difficult times!

One of our dear staff members received a positive coronavirus test today. They voluntarily got tested Friday, were, and still are completely asymptomatic. We keep a record of temperature and symptom checklist every shift and follow a complete disinfection procedure every 4 hour shift, in addition to after equipment is used.
